

Fund Monthly Report

Important note:

- 1. BEA Union Investment Asian Bond and Currency Fund (the "Fund") seeks regular interest income, capital gains and currency appreciation from an actively managed portfolio of debt securities denominated in Asian or other currencies and primarily issued by Asian government or corporate entities.

Asian High Yield Bonds Rallied Generally

Market Review and Outlook

Review of Interest Rate Market

- U.S. Treasury yields held steady in January. The U.S. Federal Reserve (Fed) reiterated its willingness to be patient on further rate adjustment at a meeting of the Federal Open Market Committee in January 2019.

Asian High Yield Bonds

- Chinese high yield property bonds rallied alongside other sectors, but to a slightly lesser extent, due to lower average duration and continuous new supply during the month. Chinese high yield industrial names were supported by a rebound in oil prices and revaluation of lower bond price.
- In the Southeast Asian markets, yield spreads tightened across the board. Indonesian property bonds rallied due to the stabilisation of the Indonesian rupiah and marketing sales figures.



Market Outlook

- The U.S.-China trade talks will likely continue to be an important factor affecting risk sentiment in general. We are seeing fairer high yields valuation overall following the recent rally.
- In terms of individual sectors, we expect to see higher risk in privately owned Chinese industrial names due to their relatively tight onshore funding. We think Indonesian property marketing sales will remain weak but stable, and are cautiously optimistic about the price of the major commodities that drive the fundamentals of many Southeast Asian industrial names.

Investment Strategy

- The Fund has been picking up bonds in the primary market, as we are seeing attractive new issue premiums. We have added to our position in Indonesian property names and longer-dated Chinese property names. The fund also added to its position in Indonesian government bonds and Chinese policy bank papers.
- We continue to prefer Indonesia's local currency bond market given the attractive carry and a likely political preference for a strong Indonesian rupiah ahead of elections in April.
- We are also positive about China's onshore bond market as the People's Bank of China is expected to launch more easing measures to support the economy.
