

Fund Special Report

Important note:

- 1. BEA Union Investment Asia Pacific Multi Income Fund (the "Fund") seeks to achieve income and long-term capital growth by investing in an actively managed portfolio of debt securities, listed REITs, and other listed securities in the Asia Pacific region.

Volatile U.S. Treasury Yields Have Minor Impact on Asian High Yield Bonds



Highlights:

- 1. Asian high yield bonds supported by solid investment demand, show stable development

Fund Features

> The Fund focuses on high yielding Asia Pacific bonds and equities, distributions from both bonds and equities are the main source of income.

Market Review and Outlook

Bonds

- U.S. Treasury yields rose sharply in January, fuelled by better-than-expected economic data and heightened inflationary expectation. Despite increased market volatility, Asian high yield bonds continued to perform well in January. Chinese high yield bonds outperformed because of their higher yield carry and the limited price pressure given strong investor demand.
- The robust economic picture could result in a faster pace of monetary policy tightening by central banks in Europe and the U.S., but the impact on the Asian bond market will most likely be gradual. We remain cautious about potential risks, including: 1) the liquidity risk of high beta credits, 2) the portfolio's duration risk, and 3) new supply pressure from the primary market.



Equities

- Mainland China finished the year with strong economic data: real GDP grew 6.8% in the fourth quarter of 2017, bringing economic growth for the whole year to 6.9% the first time it has accelerated since 2010. December's data accelerated sequentially, with industrial production and fixed asset investment up 6.2% and 6.3%, respectively.
- Strong southbound flows lifted Hong Kong's stock market higher, with mainland investors targeting especially lagging sectors such as banks. Chinese property sector also enjoyed a strong rally last month in response to the positive sales outlook.
- Economic sentiment continues to improve in Asia, with Singapore's GDP growth in the fourth quarter of 2017 stronger than expected, leading to growing confidence of a cyclical recovery.

Investment Strategy

Bonds

- The Fund continues to reduce its holdings of long-dated bonds and is switching to invest in more defensive short-dated Chinese property bonds. We also have a positive outlook on bonds in the commodities and energy-related sectors.
- The Fund added to its investment in selected Asian local currency bonds, such as in Malaysia and China, due to the strong demand from investors in these markets.

Equities

- There were few changes in the equities portfolio, as the Fund continued to add higher-yielding names in Australia and Taiwan.
- The Fund took profit on REITs in China and tactically invested in Chinese property stocks due to their stronger earnings outlook.
