

Important note:

1. Market Review and Outlook

Equities

- Both onshore and offshore markets surged in January. Stock performance was polarized, as big caps (mainly the growth stocks) gained notable traction while small and middle caps lagged.
- As for sector performance, big-cap tech powered the leading positions, while Real Estate and Financials lagged. The recent policy tightening against the housing market served as the key sentiment drag on the Real Estate sector.
- Hong Kong equity market had a strong start to the year, Southbound flows amounted to RMB260 billion in January and accounted for 43% of total inflow in 2020, with new economy growth stocks gaining traction.

Bonds

- Asia credit spread has showed constructive tightening movement on the back of supply coming short of expectation.
- In high yield space, market was affected by the sharp rise in treasury yield during the beginning of the month, which was in turn triggered by fear about tapering discussion from the Fed. There was increased amount of fund flows into Asia from emerging markets. India financial and industrial names outperformed, driven by improving commodities prices and positive credit events.

Investment Strategy

Equities

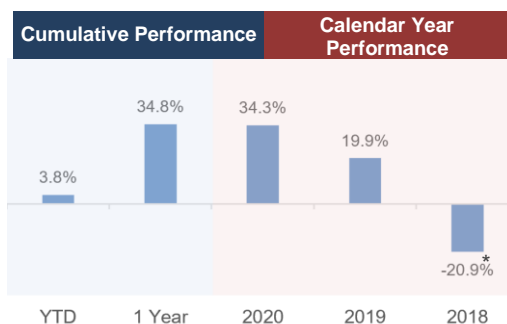
- We keep our constructive market view on favourable fiscal and monetary policy outlook, expected economic recovery supported by positive vaccine developments, as well as undemanding valuations.
- The Fund maintains a more balanced portfolio mix between growth and cyclical/recovery names. Considering the outperformance of growth names in the last 1-2 months and the steepening yield curves, we could take profit on some outperformed growth names. We would also add to financials which could benefit from steepening yield curves.
- We prefer IT, internet, health care, consumption, clean energy including electric vehicle. Industrials benefited from government supportive policies and cyclical recovery are also alpha opportunities.

Bonds

- The Fund will position cautiously optimistic. Given the relatively strong inflow to the market during the period, which will provide support to valuation of the market, especially those benchmark names.
- The fund will focus more on credit selection and reduce names with high credit risk. And the cash level would stay low.
