

Important note:

1. BEA Union Investment China Gateway Fund (the “Fund”) seeks medium to long term capital growth and income through investing primarily in equity securities and/or debt securities, that are either (a) traded in China or (b) issued by entities incorporated in China or entities which have significant operations in or assets in, or derive significant portion of revenue or profits from China.

Strong YTD Performers Turned Weak Due to Profit Taking

*Highlights:*

1. **Strong recovery in China supports future performance on Asian high yield bond.**

Market Review and OutlookEquities

- Both onshore and offshore markets declined in September. The decline was driven by the U.S.-China tensions on the technology front. The U.S. announced to impose export control over a China semiconductor manufacturer. And Trump had attempted to ban WeChat.
- In terms of sectors, those strong YTD performers, like Healthcare, IT and Consumer Staples, turned weak due to profit taking.
- Hong Kong market was down in September. Financials underperformed as a multinational financial institution may be put on China’s Unreliable Entity List. Macau casinos were down on weaker than expected Macau gross gaming revenue recovery.

Bonds

- Asia credit spread widened in September on hefty new issuance and weaker sentiments in general.
- Fed continued support in low interest rate environment and most importantly resilient and strongly recovering China economy will continue to support future performance on Asian high yield bond.

Investment Strategy

Equities

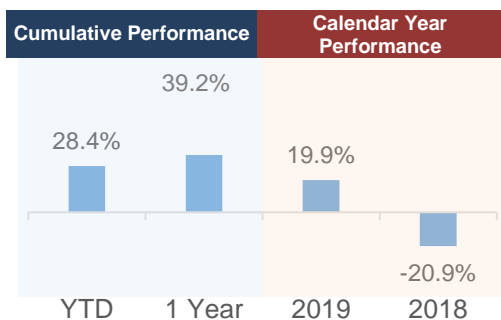
- We maintain our constructive market view thanks to the improving domestic demand outlook, strong exports trend, favourable liquidity and monetary policy. We prefer equities to bonds. We continue to focus on growth names supplemented by cyclicals and recovery plays
- In terms of sector, IT, consumer staples and industrials are our key overweight on the back of their structural demand growth story. Banks remain a key underweight. Near-term we may look to lock in profits for iPhone supply chain before new iPhone launch.
- We would continue to closely monitor external macro risks ahead of the U.S. presidential election. COVID-19 and the U.S.-China tensions are the other key risks that could fuel market volatility.

Bonds

- The Fund's duration is neutral, and reduced exposure to higher beta names as global risk sentiment shift.
- The Fund has been picking up bonds with new issue premium in the primary market on high yield and investment grade names, and trimmed names with credit concern.
